JOB TITLE: Water Utility Technician

DEPARTMENT: Distribution - Field Maintenance

SUMMARY: Under regular supervision, performs entry-level maintenance and repair of Iredell Water Corporation Distribution system. Work involves installing taps, locating, maintenance and repair of lines, rights-of-way, and operating equipment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Helps with water line construction, locates water/sewer lines, and makes water taps
- Maintains water lines and or water rights-of-way.
- Repairs broken meter boxes, replaces faulty meters, cleans-up shop and repair yard as necessary.
- Takes water samples, flushes hydrants, performs valve maintenance, etc.
- Maintains pump and booster stations, altitude valves and zone bypasses.
- Operates and maintains equipment including vehicles, trucks, excavators, power tools and hand tools.
- Landscapes yards after pipe installation or repair work.
- Regular roster rotation for "on-call" duty.
- Utilize proper safety precautions related to all work performed and participates in safety meetings as required.
- Perform work in emergency situations as required.
- May work with hazardous materials such as chlorine to sanitize new lines.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by management.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:

• This job has no supervisory responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED), or one to three years related experience and/or training, or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Must have a valid North Carolina driver's license and be able to maintain a safe driving history.
- Employment pre-placement Drug and/or Alcohol test and background check required for this position
